Habitualmente se destaca su prosperidad económica, pero no se llama tanto la atención sobre el aspecto cultural, salvo en el caso de la corte del rey al-Mutásim, en el que se hace de forma tan machacona como tópica.

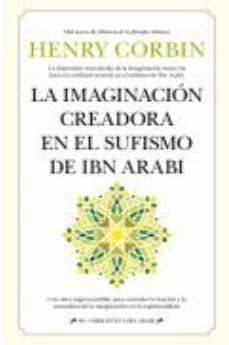

The emergence of the genre is indebted to the increasing importance of the poet, who came into increasing conflict with Ghaznavid and Saljuq sovereigns as the genre developed.
