

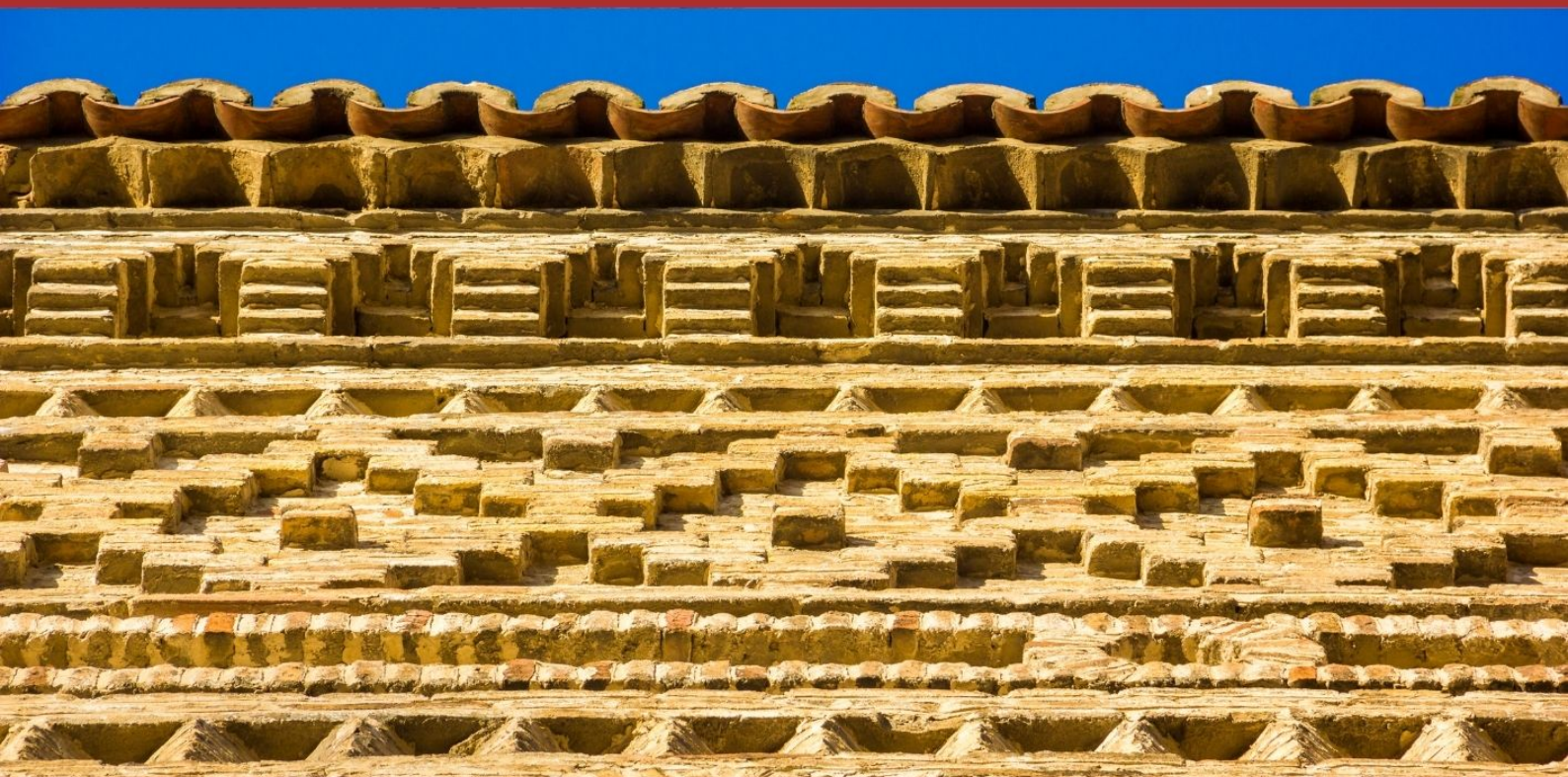


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Breaking the dšr.t Vessels : An Ancient Egyptian Fragmentation Rite



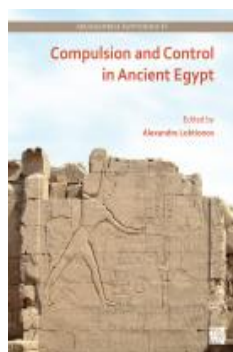

The aim of this study is to gain a better understanding of the rite through a re-evaluation of the primary sources and previous research and to provide the first study devoted entirely to the rite.

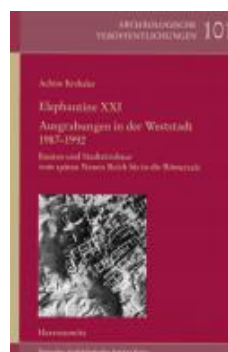

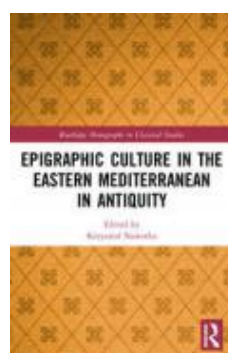

Das Grabungsgebiet besteht aus zusammenhängenden Stadtquartieren mit Bauten und Siedlungsschichten vom späten Neuen Reich bis in die Römerzeit. Der außergewöhnlich gute Erhaltungszustand ermöglichte Einblicke in die Stadtstruktur und in Details des täglichen Lebens in einer kontinuierlich bewohnten ägyptischen Stadt.

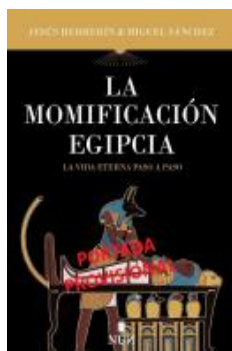

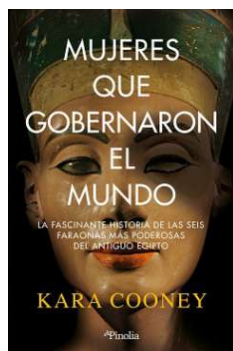
Medicine and Healing Practices in Ancient Egypt

Rather than concentrating exclusively on diseases and medical conditions as evidenced in ancient sources, it provides a 'people-focused' perspective, asking what it was like to be ill or disabled in this society? Who were the healers? To what extent did disease occurrence and treatment reflect individual social status?

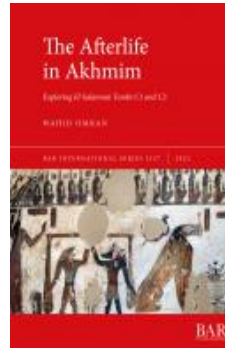

The 'Woman at the Window' Came From Egypt investigates the origin of ivory plaques found in the Assyrian palaces of Nimrud and Khorsabad from the first millennium BCE. It provides a completely new interpretation of the famous iconography of the 'Woman at the Window'. This collection of ivories, traditionally labelled as 'Phoenician', is thought to have originated from locations across the Levant. However, the Egyptian Nile Delta appears to be a more accurate locale.

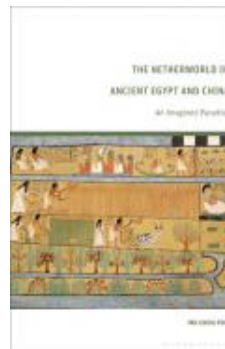

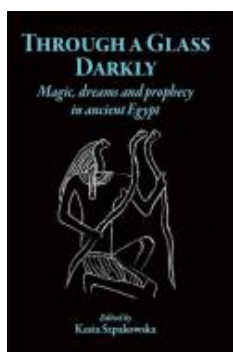
