But monks also desired the eradication of lust and the punishment of those who fell prey to it.

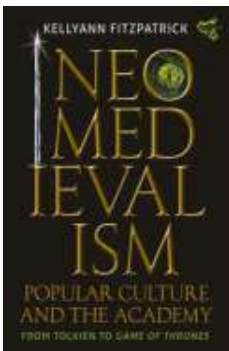

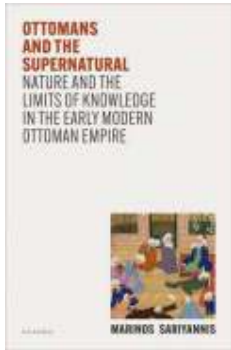

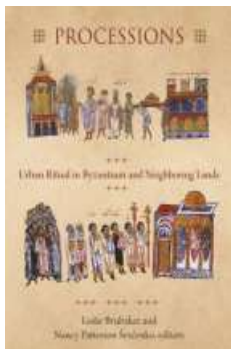

In recent years, supernatural beliefs systems in medieval and modern Islamicate cultures have been the subject of sustained scholarly attention. But we know very little about these concepts and practices in an Ottoman context.

Marinos Sariyannis proposes here to rectify this with a comprehensive exploration of Ottoman-era magic and occult sciences.
